### **POLICY ON KASHRUT November 2015**

As a Jewish school JFS follows Jewish dietary laws. It adheres to the Orthodox religious principles of the laws of Kashrut.

As part of the ethos of JFS, staff are requested to respect the Orthodox religious principles of the laws of Kashrut

As part of the ethos of JFS, students should only eat food that is certified Kosher when in school or on any school activity.

#### **General**

1. JFS is a school that adheres to the laws of Kashrut

#### **Staff**

2. Staff may only bring in their own food if it is to be consumed in one of the departmental resource bases.
3. Teachers wishing to give food to their class should purchase it from the Mezzanine Café, or ensure that it is Certified Kosher food.
4. Staff may not remove food from the Dining Hall or Mezzanine Café unless it is on disposable plates/with disposable cutlery.
5. No non- kosher food may be brought into the following areas, the Dining Hall, Mezzanine Café, Main staff room, Boardroom, or Headteacher's office by anyone, staff, or students.


#### **Students**

6. No food or drink other than fruit or water may be brought on site by students at any time.
7. Students may not take food, other than fruit and water out of the Dining Hall or Mezzanine Café.
8. Students with medical conditions that relate to dietary needs should discuss these with the relevant Year Manager who should liaise with their SLT line manager.
9. Students who fail to comply with the Kashrut policy will be the subject of sanctions incorporated in the ladder of consequences. The degree to which the Kashrut of the school is compromised will determine the sanctions imposed.

**After-School Activities**

10. Food from Caterlink or Certified Kosher food must be made available for students who are remaining for all after-School activities.
11. Staff arranging after school activities are responsible for ensuring the necessary provision of Kosher food.
