

Y11 Assessment at JFS



- Students in Y11 receive an aspirational grade which is something that they should be aiming for.
- Students will also receive an end of term grade which is the grade at which they are currently working at.
- For maths and English students will get a grade 9 -1 where 9 is the highest and 1 is the lowest.
- For all other subjects students will receive a grade from A*-G. A* is the highest and G is the lowest.
- Please see on the next page a table which shows the equivalence between GCSE grades and the new 9 -1 scores.

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The students in Y11 will get GCSE scores for maths and English from 9 – 1.

Please look at the table below to see the comparison between the GCSE grades and the 9 – 1 scores.
