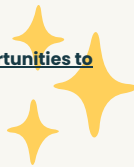

## CLEARING INFORMATION FOR Y13 PARENTS

What is clearing?

Clearing is a way to get a university place if a student:



- doesn't get the grades for their firm or insurance choice
- hasn't received any offers (or none they have wanted to accept)
- has changed their mind and no longer wants to go to their firm choice
- declined their firm place using the 'decline my place' button on in their application
- applied after 30 June
- applicants in clearing can click the 'my matches' button in their application to see a list of courses they have been matched to
- Clearing opens on 5 July, so you can view the courses available at various universities. Scan the QR to find out more . . .
